The purpose of a civility policy is to promote civility and respectful communications among district employees, students, parents, and the public. A powerful example is set for the student population when the district indicates that it expects mutual respect, civility and orderly conduct from the adults with whom the district interacts. Shipman & Goodwin provided the proposed policy.

These policies have been reviewed by the Ad-Hoc Committee for Policy Review/Revision at its meeting on September 28. Since this is a first reading, no action is required; the second reading/adoption will take place at the October 12 Board meeting.
