Athletics

Berlin High Athletics:

- ☐ Slight increase in transportation \$3,182
- Increase in contracted medical services (trainer) \$2,000 for the year
- □ Overall budget increase of \$42,723
 - irst aid, sports awards, non instructional supplies all back into budget
 - Cost of equipment has increased (expendable items)
- Allocating funding appropriately for all sports programs

McGee Athletics:

- □ Slight increase in transportation \$337
 - Overall budget is up \$6837
 - Uniform replacement Boys Basketball and Cross Country

Elementary Schools Budget

Operational Budget Request:

- -Multiple years at 0%
- -Slight increase to account for inflation

Staffing Request: 1.0 FTE classroom teacher to account for enrollment



Secondary Schools Budget

McGee Middle School:

- An increase in operational budget (approx \$75 per pupil) as per pupil expenditure at middle school was disproportionate when compared to elementary school funding
- McGee has not had an increase to its operational budget in four years
- 0 positions requested for 2024 2025

Berlin High School: increase supporting the following:

- Textbooks online subscriptions, replacements, yearly codes (TE, WL, Sci, Math, SS)
- Increased graduation costs
- All areas remain flat with some areas (Business) have a minimal increase.

Berlin High School 2024-2025 Budget

- 2.0 FTE (Math & Science teachers)
 - Large class sizes and limited seats
 - Support & interventions
- Part-time clerical position (Front office)
 - Increase in bookkeeping responsibilities, attendance, sub assignments & class coverage, aterial Prep
- Increase in Graduation Costs & Fees
 - Previously funded from accountabilities



The purpose of this budget is to support:

- Curriculum Additions, Revisions, and Updates
- Learning and Materials related to State Mandates
- Purchase of materials for new courses
- Professional Learning for all staff (in district and out of district)
- Software Subscriptions for Teaching and Learning



<u>Instructional Supplies</u> - ESOL supplies, classroom support materials, summer reading supplies and books

Other Professional Services - Elementary Author Visits, Adult Education

Other Certified Salaries - Curriculum Writing, Teachers as Leaders of Professional Learning

<u>T&L Software</u> - Instructional software for the district; all curriculum areas; school libraries; large increase because multiple year contracts are expiring (ESSER)

<u>In District PD</u> - Literacy (reading - state legislation), Math, CTE Consultant, consultants for other departments

Out of District PD - Librarians, teacher leaders, department PD (music, PE, art), AP training, PowerSchool Training

Staff Travel - For all staff between buildings and attending out-of-district professional learning sessions

Non Instructional Supplies - Materials to purchase supplies for meetings

<u>Admin Supplies</u> - Purchased materials for Professional Learning and Curriculum Updates - often books to support new learning, Art Around Town, District Art Show, Kindergarten Orientation & Welcome, Kindergarten Assessment (state legislation)



<u>Textbooks</u> - Textbooks for new courses, updated AP texts, pilot reading texts (state legislation)

<u>Tuition</u> - Independent Study, CNA

Other Professional Services - Author Visits

Dues & Fees - Professional Organizations

<u>Field Trips</u> - Transition Trips (elementary to middle, middle to high), learning about Berlin, elementary science (High Touch High Tech)



Special Education Budget - \$13,801,486

The purpose of this budget is to support:

- The learning and social and emotional needs of students with an Individualized Education Plan from 3-22 years old.
 - Certified and non certified salaries and benefits
 - Instructional Supplies
 - Contracted Services
 - Equipment
 - Tuition and transportation
 - Central Connecticut Transition Academy
 - Extended School Year Services (summer school)

The Special Education Budget is approximately 25.5% of the General Fund Budget

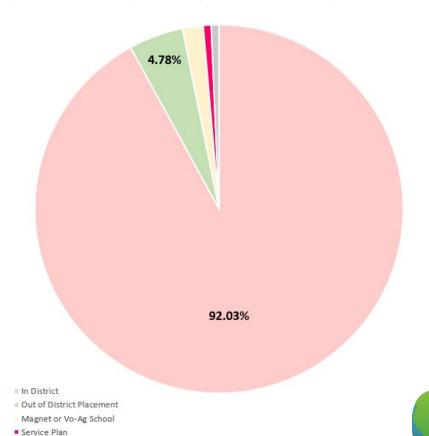

Special Education Budget

<u>Contracted Services</u>: ESS services at BHS and McGee Middle School, outside evaluators, interpreter services, field trips, ESY nursing services, one on one nursing services, hearing impaired services, Compuclaim services, legal fees, Assistive Technology services and PMT training.

<u>Supplies</u>: OT, PT, speech/language, and special education teachers purchase supplies needed to work with their students. This may include; books, fidgets, sensory material, testing materials, rewards, and therapy materials.

Equipment: Adaptive seating equipment for students with physical and motor needs.

Special Education Tuition

Special Education Tuitions: We currently have 20 students attending out of district placements. Tuitions range from \$79,000 to \$299,279 and transportation ranges from \$18,655 to \$72,054.

2 unanticipated tuitions = \$99,923/student

Magnet Schools: Currently 5 students attending Magnet Schools. Tuitions range from \$7,725 to \$14,420.

2 anticipated tuitions = \$15,450

2024 - 2025 Projected Out of District: BOE General Fund

Tuition: \$2,114,570

Transportation: \$384,462

Total: \$2,499,041
