

BERLIN PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT

The Parks and Recreation Department will begin registration on March 15 for its annual **Youth Fishing Derbies** which will be held at Sage Park Pond. Both derbies will be held from **8-10 a.m.**, Saturday, April 17 for ages 3-7 and Saturday, April 24 for ages 8-15 for **Berlin youth only**. *An adult must accompany ages 3-10*. You must pre-register to be able to participate in the derby, be eligible for the prizes and to fish at the pond during the end of April and the entire month of May. This is a free event! The deadline to register is the Friday before each event. ****Remember the Parks and Recreation Department closes at 1 p.m. on Friday!!****. You must be present when your name is called to win a prize. There is a limit of 5 fish per child and only one fishing pole in the water per child. The event will be held if raining, however, in case of severe storms call the recorder phone for information.

PLEASE NOTE – From April 17-May 31, only 3-15 year old **Berlin Residents** are allowed to fish at Sage Park Pond. An adult can accompany youth, if supervision is necessary. **The pond is closed to the public on Friday, April 16 and Friday, April 23**. All other uses of the pond for fishing during this time are prohibited.



Registration can be done through our WebTrac system or printing a registration form and mailing it in. If you would like to register in person, you must call the office to make an appointment, the Parks and Recreation Department is currently closed to the public.
