## Dance classes

Students will begin working on dance steps, concepts and choreography. Ballet and Tap shoes are preferred but not required. Class will be held on Saturday's from 10:15-11 a.m. Classes meet starting October 16 for 4 classes. Fee is \$40 for residents and \$50 for non-residents. **Program #320201B**
