AGREEMENT Berlin Board of Education And Read Naturally Inc.

For the purposes of this Agreement, "directory information," "de-identified student information," "school purposes," "student information," "student records," "student generated content," and "targeted advertising" shall be as defined by Conn. Gen. Stat. § 10-234aa.

- 1. All student records, student information, and student-generated content (collectively, "student data") provided or accessed pursuant to the contract are not the property of, or under the control of, the Contractor.
- 2. The Board shall have access to and the ability to delete student data in the possession of the Contractor except in instances where such data is (A) otherwise prohibited from deletion or required to be retained under state or federal law, or (B) stored as a copy as part of a disaster recovery storage system and that is (i) inaccessible to the public, and (ii) unable to be used in the normal course of business by the Contractor. The Board may request the deletion of any such student information, student records or student-generated content if such copy has been used by the operator to repopulate accessible data following a disaster recovery. The Board may request the deletion of student data by sending such request to the Contractor by electronic mail at devans@readnaturally.com. The Contractor will delete the requested student data within two (2) business days of receiving such a request.
- 3. The Contractor shall not use student data for any purposes other than those authorized pursuant to the Terms of Service: (See attached Software Subscription Agreement and Privacy and Security Policy for complete Terms of Service)
- 4. A student, parent or legal guardian of a student may review personally identifiable information contained in student data and correct any erroneous information, if any, in such student data. If a student, parent or legal guardian contacts the Contractor directly and requests to review student data in possession of the Contractor, the Contractor agrees to refer that individual to the Board and to notify the Board within two (2) business days of receiving such a request. The Contractor agrees to work cooperatively with the Board to permit a student, parent, or guardian to review personally identifiable information in student data that has been shared with the Contractor, and correct any erroneous information therein, by following the amendment procedures outlined in the Board's Confidentiality and Access to Education Records Policy, 5125 and 5125-R (regulations).
- The Contractor shall take actions designed to ensure the security and confidentiality of student data.
- 6. The Contractor will notify the Board, in accordance with Conn. Gen. Stat. § 10- 234dd, when there has been an unauthorized release, disclosure or acquisition of student data. Such notification will include the following steps:

- a. Notice of the breach shall be delivered to the Board by electronic mail to the SysAdmins serveradmins@berlinschools.org and shall include the following information, to the extent known at the time of notification:
 - i. Date and time of the breach;
 - Names of student(s) whose student data was released, disclosed or acquired;
 - iii. The nature and extent of the breach;
 - iv. The Contractor's proposed plan to investigate and remediate the breach.
- 7. Student data shall not be retained or available to the Contractor upon expiration of the contract between the Contractor and Board, except a student, parent or legal guardian of a student may choose independently to establish or maintain an electronic account with the Contractor after the expiration of such contract for the purpose of storing student-generated content.
- 8. The Contractor and Board shall each ensure their own compliance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974, 20 U.S.C. § 1232g, as amended from time to time.
- 9. The laws of the State of Connecticut shall govern the rights and duties of the Contractor and the Board.
- 10. If any provision of the contract or the application of the contract is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of the contract which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application.
- 11. The Contractor acknowledges and agrees to comply with the above and all other applicable aspects of Connecticut's Student Data Privacy law according to Connecticut General Statutes §§ 10-234aa through 10-234dd.
- 12. The Parties agree that this Agreement controls over any inconsistent terms or conditions contained within any other agreement entered into by the Parties concerning student data.

Read Live Software Subscription Agreement

Read Live is an educational program provided by Read Naturally, Inc. ("Read Naturally") that consists of a web-based application and an optional, corresponding iPad App. The use of Read Live is subject to the following terms and conditions (collectively, the "Agreement"). As used in this Agreement, the terms "we," "us," and "our" refer to Read Naturally, and "customer," "you," and "your" refer to anyone that purchases, accesses or uses Read Live (each a "Party" and collectively the "Parties").

BY USING READ LIVE, YOU ACKNOWLEDGE THAT YOU HAVE READ, UNDERSTAND, AND AGREE TO BE BOUND BY THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THIS AGREEMENT. IF YOU DO NOT AGREE TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THIS AGREEMENT, YOU MUST DISCONTINUE USE OF READ LIVE IMMEDIATELY.

PROGRAM CONTENTS

All materials included within Read Live (including, without limitation, text, graphics, logos, button icons, images, videos, audio clips and software) as well as the collection, arrangement and assembly of these materials are the property of Read Naturally, its licensors and service providers, or the parties specifically indicated, and are protected by U.S. and international property and copyright laws. The materials within Read Live may be used solely as provided in this Agreement. Any other use of the materials within Read Live is strictly prohibited. Read Naturally, Read Live and any other Read Naturally graphics, logos and service names are trademarks and service marks of Read Naturally. All other marks contained within Read Live are the sole property of Read Naturally's licensors or of the parties indicated.

II. CUSTOMER DATA

Read Live collects and stores Customer Data as part of its normal use and operation. "Customer Data" includes any data that Customer loads or enters into the program and all results from processing such data, including compilations and derivative works thereof. Customer Data belongs to the Customer. Customer expressly reserves all rights in the Customer Data, except the limited right of Company to use the Customer Data in operating Read Live features for Customer's benefit.

Additional policies regarding Customer Data privacy and security, as detailed in our Read Live Privacy and Security Policy, are hereby incorporated into this agreement. The Read Live Privacy and Security Policy can be found within Read Live and on the Read Naturally web site.

III. LIMITED LICENSE AND PROGRAM USE

Customer may subscribe to Read Live by placing an order with Read Naturally or by submitting a request to use the program for a trial period. The order or request will specify the maximum number of students that will have access to the program and the length of the subscription period. Upon acceptance of the order or request by Read Naturally, and subject to the terms of this Agreement, Read Naturally grants

you limited, revocable, nonexclusive, nontransferable access and use of the program for educational, informational, and noncommercial use. You may extend the subscription period and/or add student licenses by submitting additional orders or requests. Additional orders or requests are subject to approval by Read Naturally. You are not entitled to any refund or credit for unused licenses or periods of non-use.

Read Live may only be used by authorized users for lawful purposes. Except as otherwise stated in this Agreement, you may not modify, copy, distribute, transmit, post, display, perform, reproduce, publish, broadcast, license, create derivative works from, transfer, sell, or exploit any reports, data, information, content, or other materials on, generated by or obtained from Read Live.

Use of the optional iPad App may require additional agreements with Apple Inc. These additional agreements, if any, are made between you and Apple Inc., and shall have no impact on this Agreement.

Read Live is protected by the use of user IDs and passwords, and you are required to log in to use the program. You agree not to disclose or share your password with any third party. You are responsible for maintaining the confidentiality of your user ID and password. You shall be responsible for all uses of your account, whether or not authorized by you. You agree to immediately notify Read Naturally of any unauthorized use of your account, username or password.

Read Naturally expressly reserves all rights in Read Live not specifically granted to Customer. It is acknowledged that all right, title and interest in Read Live will remain with Read Naturally (or third party suppliers, if applicable) and that Read Live is licensed on a subscription basis and not "sold" to Customer. Unless specifically agreed in writing, each Party's exclusive ownership rights extend to any update, adaptation, translation, customization or derivative work thereof.

IV. TERM AND TERMINATION

The term of this Agreement will begin upon the activation of your Read Live account and will continue until the expiration or termination of all subsequent orders and extensions.

Either Party may, in addition to other relief, suspend or terminate this Agreement if the other Party breaches any material provision hereof and fails within thirty (30) days after receipt of notice of default to correct such default or to commence corrective action reasonably acceptable to the aggrieved Party and proceed with due diligence to completion. Termination shall have no effect on the Parties' rights or obligations as specified in this agreement in regards to data privacy and security protections, warranties, indemnities, limitation of liabilities, payment obligations or any provision which by its nature should survive.

V. EXTERNAL CONTENT

Read Naturally may provide, or third parties may provide, links to other web sites or resources that are beyond Read Naturally's control. Read Naturally makes no representations as to the quality, suitability, functionality or legality of any sites to which links may be provided, and you hereby waive any claim you might have against Read Naturally with respect to such sites. READ NATURALLY IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CONTENT ON THE INTERNET OR WEB PAGES THAT ARE CONTAINED OUTSIDE OF READ LIVE. If you decide to access linked third party web sites, you do so at your own risk.

VI. SUPPORT, UPDATES, AND UPGRADES

Read Naturally will provide technical support by phone and email during our normal business hours. If necessary, and subject to normal security procedures, Read Naturally's support staff may access Customer Data in Read Live to diagnose and correct reported problems. Support service does not include any on-site service, preparation of Customer Data, or customization of features needed to function in your specific operating environment. You acknowledge that certain system requirements must be met in order to use Read Live, and that Read Naturally is not responsible for problems that arise from unsupported system configurations.

From time to time, Read Naturally will release updates and upgrades to Read Live. The contents and timing of these releases will be at the sole discretion of Read Naturally. Read Naturally will send advance notification via email when any scheduled release will impact the program's system requirements. It is your responsibility to ensure that your operating environment remains compatible with these system requirements.

VII. TRANSFER OF AGREEMENT

Except as expressly stated herein, neither this Agreement, nor any rights or obligations hereunder, may be transferred, assigned, delegated, sublicensed, time-shared, or rented, in whole or in part, by Customer without Read Naturally's prior written consent and any attempt to the contrary shall be void and of no legal effect.

VIII. WARRANTIES

Read Naturally represents and warrants to the best of its knowledge and belief that the use of Read Live will not infringe or misappropriate any Intellectual Property Rights. Upon being notified of such a claim, Read Naturally shall at its option: (i) defend through litigation or obtain through negotiation the right of Customer to continue using Read Live; (ii) rework Read Live so as to make it noninfringing while preserving the original functionality, or (iii) replace Read Live with functionally equivalent software. If none of the foregoing alternatives provide an adequate remedy, Customer may terminate this Agreement and recover an equitable partial or full refund of amounts paid for the then current subscription period. Customer represents and warrants that it owns or has all requisite rights to use the Customer Data loaded or entered into Read Live, and to authorize Read Naturally to process Customer Data as contemplated herein, and that such use will not infringe or misappropriate any Intellectual Property Rights.

Read Naturally represents and warrants that during the subscription period it will use best efforts to ensure that Read Live operates substantially in accordance with the applicable Documentation; provided, that (i) Read Live is implemented and operated in accordance with all instructions supplied by Read Naturally; (ii) Customer notifies Read Naturally of any such defect within ten (10) calendar days after the appearance thereof; (iii) Customer has properly used all updates made available with respect to Read Live, and updates recommended by Read Naturally with respect to any third party software products that materially affect the performance of Read Live; (iv) Customer has properly maintained all associated equipment, software and environmental conditions in accordance with applicable specifications and industry standards; (v) Customer has not introduced other equipment or software creating an adverse impact on Read Live; and (vi) Customer has paid all amounts due hereunder and is not in default of any provision of this Agreement.

Read Naturally represents that it shall, prior to making Read Live generally available for use, use commercially available anti-virus software and shall use reasonable efforts to remove viruses capable of being detected with such software.

EXCEPT AS SPECIFICALLY PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION ("WARRANTIES") READ NATURALLY HEREBY DISCLAIMS WITH RESPECT TO ALL SERVICES, SUPPORT OR OTHER DELIVERABLES PROVIDED HEREUNDER, ALL EXPRESS AND IMPLIED WARRANTIES, INCLUDING ANY IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY, TITLE, ACCURACY, QUALITY, INTEGRATION OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. COMPANY DOES NOT WARRANT THAT THE SERVICE WILL OPERATE WITHOUT INTERRUPTION OR ERROR FREE. ANY UNAUTHORIZED CHANGES TO SOURCE CODE TO THE SERVICE WILL VOID THE WARRANTY PROVIDED UNDER THIS SECTION.

IX. MUTUAL INDEMNITY

Read Naturally shall defend, indemnify and hold Customer harmless from any claim (including attorney fees) that Read Live violates or infringes any Intellectual Property Rights; provided that Read Naturally is given prompt notice of the claim and sole control over the defense and any settlement thereof (except Read Naturally shall not enter into any settlement prejudicial to Customer without Customer's consent). Read Naturally is not obligated under this Section to the extent any claim arises from Customer's breach of this Agreement.

Customer shall defend, indemnify and hold Read Naturally harmless from any claim (including attorney fees) that Customer Data or Customer's use of Read Live harms any person, violates any law or infringes any Intellectual Property Rights; provided that Customer is given prompt notice of the claim and sole control over the defense and any settlement of any third party claim (except Customer shall not enter into any settlement prejudicial to Read Naturally without Read Naturally's consent). Customer is not obligated under this Section to the extent any claim arises from Read Naturally's breach of this Agreement.

X. CHOICE OF LAW

This Agreement may be interpreted in accordance with the common laws of the State of Minnesota and with the substantive laws of the United States.

XI. ARBITRATION

Any dispute or claim arising from or relating to this Agreement (or breach thereof) that cannot be resolved promptly by the parties shall be resolved by arbitration in accordance with the rules, then obtaining, of the American Arbitration Association. It is understood that neither this Agreement nor the Rules of the American Arbitration Association shall confer jurisdiction on any courts of the individual States or of the United States. It is further understood that arbitration as set forth in this paragraph is the exclusive remedy for any dispute or claim related to this Agreement.

XII. LIMITED REMEDIES AND LIABILITIES

Except for indemnified claims as defined by this Agreement or rights or indemnities expressly stated under other provisions hereof, Customer's sole and exclusive remedies for Read Naturally's default hereunder shall be (a) to obtain the repair, replacement or correction of the defective program or

service to the extent, if any, warranted by this Agreement or, (b) if Company reasonably determines that such remedy is not economically or technically feasible, to obtain an equitable partial or full refund of amounts paid with respect to the defective program or service. It is agreed that these remedies shall be exclusive even if they fail of their essential purpose.

EXCEPT FOR INDEMNITIES EXPRESSLY PROVIDED BY THIS AGREEMENT, NEITHER PARTY IS LIABLE FOR DIRECT DAMAGES EXCEEDING ONE (1) YEAR'S SUBSCRIPTION FEES, NOR FOR ANY CLAIM, WHETHER IN CONTRACT, TORT (INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE) OR OTHERWISE, FOR ANY INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES (INCLUDING LOST SAVINGS, LOST PROFIT OR BUSINESS INTERRUPTION EVEN IF NOTIFIED IN ADVANCE OF SUCH POSSIBILITY) ARISING OUT OF OR PERTAINING TO THIS AGREEMENT. THIS LIMITATION IS INDEPENDENT OF REMEDY LIMITS.

Read Naturally reserves the right to revise, amend or modify the terms of this Agreement at any time and in any manner at its sole discretion. Please check these terms periodically for changes. Notice of any revision, amendment or modification of the terms will be posted in this section of the Site, and any such revisions, amendment, or modifications will be effective upon the posting of such notice. In addition, we may elect to notify you in other manners, at our sole discretion. Continued use of the Read Live by you constitutes your binding acceptance of such revisions, amendments, and modifications. XV. MISCELLANEOUS

Read Live Privacy and Security Policy

Read Live is an educational program provided by Read Naturally, Inc. that consists of a web-based application and an optional, corresponding iPad App. Read Naturally considers the privacy of all users, and especially the security and confidentiality of student data, to be extremely important.

Several federal and state laws govern measures to secure and protect student data. To help your educational institution comply with these laws, Read Naturally has adopted certain practices, and requires that educators using Read Live fulfill certain responsibilities, to safeguard student data. This document describes the practices we employ to secure and protect this data.

By using Read Live, you consent to these practices and agree to accept the responsibilities described below. If you have any questions about this document, we can be reached via e-mail at info@readnaturally.com or by phone at 800.788.4085.

DATA COLLECTED

Read Live collects only information that is required for the program to effectively improve students' reading skills and enable teachers and other staff members to efficiently administer the program.

Student data: Read Live collects information about students who use the program, including but not limited to name, grade, school, and scores and other results from working in the program. The student record may also contain the name, telephone number, and email address of the student's parent or guardian.

Staff Member data: Read Live collects information about users who administer the program, including but not limited to name, telephone number, and email address. Staff members can correct or update their information using the "My Profile" link within Read Live.

Read Live collects non-personally identifiable information for the purposes of evaluating, monitoring, and improving the program's functionality and performance. This information includes but is not limited to a user's IP address, domain information, and "cookie" information. A cookie is a piece of data stored on the user's hard drive containing information about the user. Read Live uses cookie information to help provide an enhanced functional system experience to those visiting the site. If a user rejects the cookie, the user may still use the site.

DATA ENTRY AND DATA QUALITY

Read Naturally operates in compliance with the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act ("COPPA"). We will not knowingly collect or use personal information from anyone under 13 years of age.

You, as a user authorized by your educational institution, control what user data is entered in Read Live.

Student data entered on this site should be limited to information that is relevant to the legitimate educational purpose of improving student performance. We will not ask you to enter, and you should not enter, data about students that is not relevant to this legitimate educational purpose.

Because you enter the student and staff member data stored in Read Live, you control its accuracy. If you discover that this data in Read Live is inaccurate or if it changes, you are responsible for correcting the information in your account.

Authorized staff members may delete student and staff member data from Read Live. Deleting a student removes all data pertaining to that student, including personal data and scores. Upon deletion, Read Naturally no longer has access to the user data, and the data cannot be recovered.

Requests by students, parents, or guardians to review, access or correct student data shall be handled by you. If you need assistance in complying with such requests, or if you need any assistance entering, accessing, or correcting the user data in Read Live, please contact Read Naturally.

Students may retain possession and control of their student data by notifying you or your educational institution in writing of such request. You must in turn provide a written request to Read Naturally to transfer the appropriate student data to a personal Read Live account, to be accessed and controlled by the student. Read Naturally will complete such requests within five (5) business days. Standard subscription fees will apply to the personal account.

OWNERSHIP AND USE

Read Naturally does not own, nor does it control, the student data entered into Read Live. Student data will be used by Read Naturally and its authorized contractors for the sole purpose of providing contracted services to the educational institution. Read Naturally will not disclose, sell, rent or otherwise use this data in any manner other than that described in this document. Read Naturally will not use data entered in Read Live to market products or services directly to students or their parents or guardians.

Read Naturally may use de-identified student data in research, product development, and marketing. This non-personally identifiable data may be shared with third parties.

In the event that Read Naturally wishes to release aggregated data that identifies your educational institution by name, Read Naturally will enter into a separate agreement with you to authorize its release and publication.

From time to time, Read Naturally sends out informational communications about Read Live, relying on the Staff Member data it has collected. These communications include but are not limited to announcements of new releases, notifications that the system will be unavailable due to scheduled maintenance, and information on efficiently using the program. These communications are sent to staff members only, not to students or their parents or guardians.

DISCLOSURE AND STORAGE

Read Naturally will only disclose student data to authorized representatives of your educational institution, and will not knowingly disclose the student data to any third person without express written authorization. You may not disclose or otherwise use the student data entered on this site for any unauthorized purposes. Your educational institution may from time to time request that Read Naturally provide student data to third parties of its choosing. We will do so with written authorization, which acknowledges that Read Naturally is providing that data as your educational institution's agent and that once the data is received by the third party, Read Naturally no longer has any control over the use or disposition of the data.

Read Naturally will not keep student data after your educational institution instructs us in writing to destroy it. If a reasonable amount of time passes after an educational institution's Read Live subscription lapses, Read

Naturally may, at its discretion, destroy the student data for the lapsed account, even without a specific request from that institution to do so.

In the unlikely event of the unauthorized disclosure of personally identifiable student data, Read Naturally will notify the educational institution of the breach in writing. Read Naturally does not have sufficient contact information to identify and notify other affected parties. Therefore, Read Naturally and your educational institution must work together in good faith to identify and notify the appropriate affected parties.

SECURITY SAFEGUARDS

Read Naturally employs certain practices and safeguards to help educational institutions meet the requirements of the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act ("FERPA").

We are committed to protecting student data against unauthorized access, use, modification, destruction, or disclosure. Protecting student data requires efforts from us and from you. We will implement reasonable and appropriate safeguards when collecting student data from you and when storing that student data in our database and you will observe our security safeguards and exercise reasonable caution when using this site.

Specific institutional and technological security safeguards include:

- Read Naturally will only authorize access to the program to trained employees and contractors who
 are necessary to provide service to the educational institution and to support the development of
 the program.
- The educational institution should only allow authorized employees to access the educational
 institution's data. The use of Staff Member Roles within the program allow the educational
 institution to designate specific levels of access to student data.
- Each user authorized by the educational institution is given a unique user ID and password. You must safeguard your username and password, and not permit any unauthorized access to student data entered or kept in the Read Live system.
- 4. Upon written request by the educational institution, Read Naturally will destroy any student data for educational institutions that no longer subscribe to the Read Live program. Read Naturally will provide written verification that the data has been destroyed as requested.
- 5. Read Naturally uses industry standard server and network hardware and software to ensure that data is protected from unauthorized access or disclosure.
- 6. Student users do not have access to links to external websites once they log into Read Live. However, Staff Member users may find links to web sites owned and operated by other organizations. Please note that when you click on one of these links, you are moving to another web site. While we reviewed the linked sites at the time of the posting of the link, and only provide a link if we believe the content of a site might be of interest to Read Live users, the content of those linked sites is the responsibility of the organization actually owning and/or operating the site. Read Naturally is not responsible for the content of any linked site. We encourage you to read the privacy statements of any linked site as its privacy policy may differ from Read Naturally's policy.
