Facilities Related Updates – Code Renovations – Berlin High School □ Director of Business Operations Roman J. Czuchta reported the high school had to close early on Monday, June 1, 2015, due to leaks in the roof, the majority of which were in the old section of the school, caused by a blockage in the drainage. There was some damage to the new section of the school and several pin holes were found throughout the new science rooms. The contractor will make the necessary repairs to the sections that were damaged. The administrative offices and media center are ready for furniture, which has started to arrive; however, these spaces will not be occupied until mid-August due to the parking lot construction and the lack of access to the building. The staff will be relocated to McGee School. The antenna has been installed and the radio station is broadcasting. Patterson Way will revert back to a two-way traffic pattern when school concludes.
